### PROGRAM: Technical College of the Rockies - Health Education and Innovation Center

Betsy introduced Kaitlyn Jones, Executive Director of the Delta Hospital Foundation. She spoke about plans for the Technical College of the Rockies (TCR) to renovate and expand into the former City Market and Chaco facility in Delta. With funding help from a State grant for Area Technical Colleges, ground breaking is scheduled for Summer of 2020. The current facility is overcrowded and inconveniently located out of town. The new facility will focus on training health care providers with classes for



LPN, CNA and EMT students. With the additional space, the school will be able to offer night classes to enable students to continue working while upgrading their skills. The new center is expected to enroll students in Spring of 2022. Along with classrooms and labs for the various fields of study, there will also be a conference space capable of seating over 300 occupants.

The Delta Hospital Foundation is involved because the hospital needs the graduates from the various TCR programs to staff the hospital.

On February 24<sup>th</sup> at 7:30pm, the Delta Hospital Foundation in partnership with the Western Colorado Area Health Education Center will be presenting the documentary "The Providers", free of charge at the Paradise.
