PROGRAM: Farewell to Felix

To say farewell to longtime Rotary member Felix Belmont, who is leaving town after 40 years to stay with his daughter in Indiana, the Club had a rare in-person meeting in Town Park.

The proceedings began with President Bliss presenting Felix with a plaque commemorating his long service to Rotary in general and to the Scholarship Committee in particular.

Then, members took turns stepping to the mic and recounting memories and thoughts about Felix over the years.

One recurring theme was Felix' long support for KVNF, particularly his unique and remarkable capability at fund raising. He joined the station shortly after moving to town and realized the one thing he could do to help was to raise money. His prowess at this is legendary, and was marveled at by several of the members



who took the mic. His direct approach ("We need your money") was very effective, and he worked his magic on a lot of people. One member said that KVNF would have never survived without Felix. Felix, in turn, said that KVNF became his "thing to do" in retirement. He attributed his reaching 102 years of age to KVNF and what it meant to him. KVNF helped him survive as he had helped KVNF.

Felix was also long-time member of Rotary and chairman of the Rotary Scholarship Committee. He was recognized as having been a totally devoted chairman, partly because he himself was a recipient of a Rotary scholarship which paid his entrance fees when he started school at Johns Hopkins University. Felix also served as club secretary for a number of years.

Felix also supported the Blue Sage and at one point provided the community with a memorable evening when he acted as MC for a 1940's Big Band Concert. Felix, an expert on Big Band music, *became* Glenn Miller when he put on his white dinner jacket and took the mic. He said his interest in Big Band music began when Glenn Miller and his orchestra performed at his graduation ceremony from Johns Hopkins.

Some recounted Felix' participation in Rotary trips to Jamaica in support of Jamaica Outreach. He had also been active in recruiting members for the Paonia Chamber of Commerce.

Felix was lauded as an "institution builder" in the town, and in the process became something of an institution himself. He is a "remarkable person" and a "wonderful man" who "inspires love everywhere" and will be dearly missed by everyone in the valley who knows him.
