ANNOUNCEMENTS:

- We had a 67% turnout for the Zoom meeting today.

PROGRAM: Midway Schoolhouse

Marsha introduced Jessica Elliott-Middleton, the owner and renovator of the Midway Schoolhouse. She is a historical architect and is thus the perfect person to take on a project such as this.

Ms. Elliott explained that she and her husband moved here a couple of years ago to a place in Midway near the school. Finding that the schoolhouse was for sale, they purchased it and along with local contractor Charlie Bishop, took on the project of renovating the building.

The land had been donated by Kevin Parks' grandfather in the late 1800's. The current schoolhouse was built in 1920 to replace a previous building that burned down. Classes were conducted there through the early 1950's. It was sold by the county and converted into a home in the 1980's.

The building contained two classrooms, one of which was still in original condition, as was the basement. In addition, the original walls and floors were still in place behind newer sheetrock and flooring, and most could be salvaged. The original windows were also salvaged. The original chalkboards (some still containing curriculum) were also found.

A full-sized kitchen was installed in the basement, with the goal of returning the building to the community as some sort of event space. This required replacing the original concrete floor as well as improving drainage to prevent flooding. An ADA-compliant bathroom was also installed in the basement. Signatures from Kevin Parks' father, grandfather and great uncle were found in the floor of the original coal room (which likely dated back to the original schoolhouse that had burned).

Jackie Parks located the original piano that had been in the schoolhouse which was donated back to the schoolhouse. It is now in one of the classrooms.

When the new septic system was installed, the original privy (a two-holer) was unearthed. The structure around the privy was no longer there. It not possible to salvage the privy and it had to be re-buried.
